

Leave Your Legacy: How to Remember the LCB in Your Will

There are two ways to support the Lansing Concert Band in your estate plan. The LCB General Fund pays for expenses of the band each concert season. Your bequest to this fund will help to offset those expenses. When you name the LCB Endowment Fund in your estate plan, you leave a legacy for generations to come. Both allow the LCB to further its musical mission. The text below is a guide to how you can include either or both funds in your will, trust, or other estate plan.

Bequest to the LCB General Fund

Your entire gift will be available for the LCB to use at any time.

Box 11152, Lansing, Michigan 48901-11152, IRS Tax Identification Number 38-2474910, to be used for the benefit and unrestricted use of the Lansing Concert Band Association. The estate executor should make checks payable to The Lansing Concert Band.

Bequest to the LCB Endowment Fund

Your gift will be combined with many others, and the annual earnings on the fund will be used by the LCB forever creating an enduring legacy.
